



What was your main reason to attend the course?

- gaining international experience, networking and getting to know new people, interesting topics (rural development, green and silver economies), explore country and culture of Lithuania, inspiration for one's own work with MA-thesis

What went well during this course? What should we keep doing next time?

- good and relevant lectures (but not all of them, e.g., lectures held in Klaipeda were criticized), excursions with coverable and many-sided views (but length of excursion and its usefulness for the group works was questioned, too), field-works and face-to-face interviews with varied local informants, supportiveness of teachers and good communication with them (not fully shared opinion among students, see table above, esp. rows 6, 9 & 10)

What did not go so well? What would you like to see done differently next time?

- tight schedule, unequal living conditions during field-works, more time for the group work and reporting, better utilization of course Dropbox contents (more likely few well selected joint readings than rich and varied collection of journal articles and book chapters)

Can you mention positive learning experiences?

- practicing and writing English, practicing interpretation and translation, acquainted with real group work in authentic alien circumstances and in time squeeze, a lot of new information concerning rural development issues in Lithuania My goal, contribution & motivation for achieving knowledge: literature, lectures, excursions, presentations, data-collection, reporting, teamwork, student-teacher interaction
