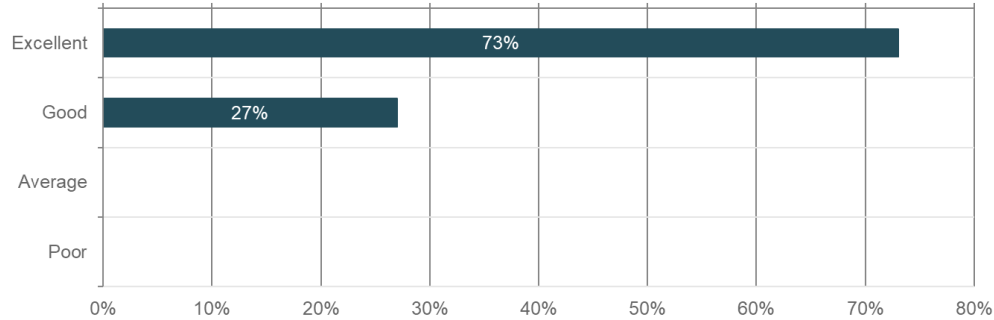

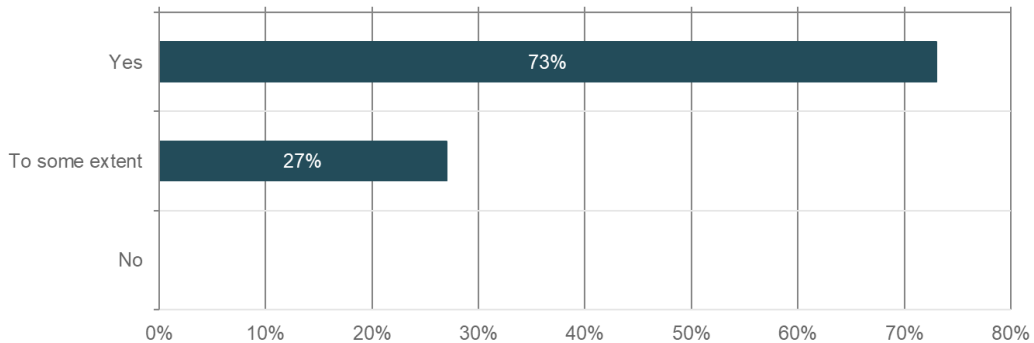

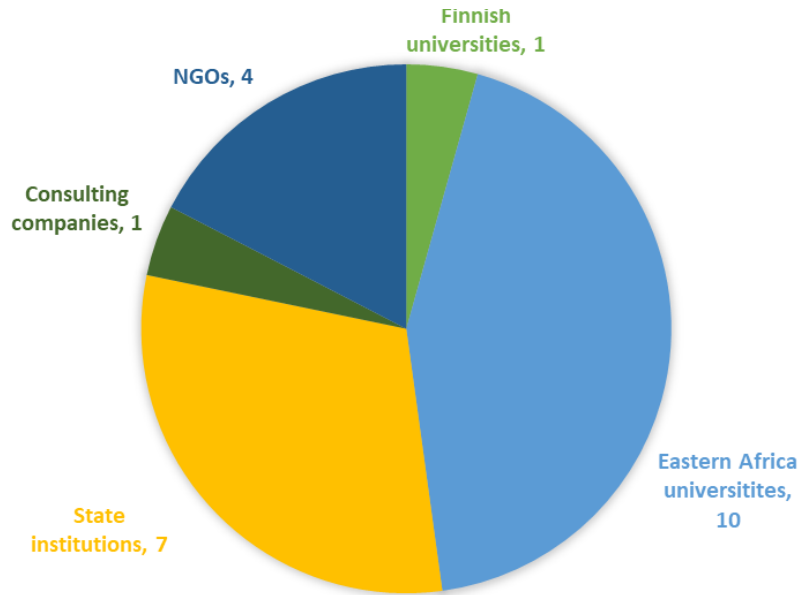
Environmental Collaboration and Conflict Resolution: Land-related issues and small-scale private forestry in Tanzania

- 23 students (all in person) and 7 teachers (in person and online)

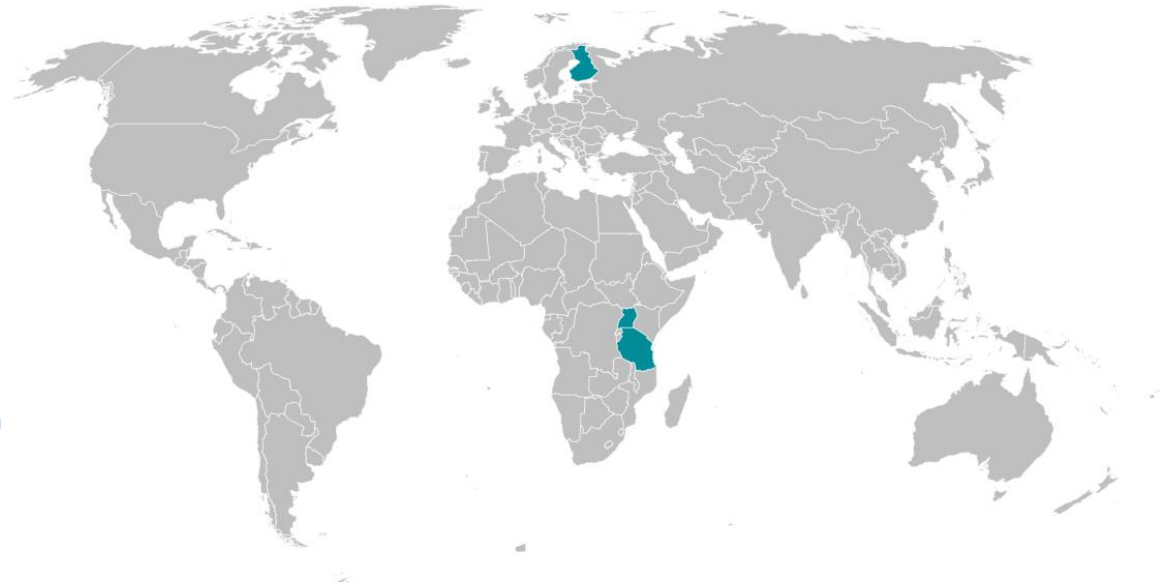

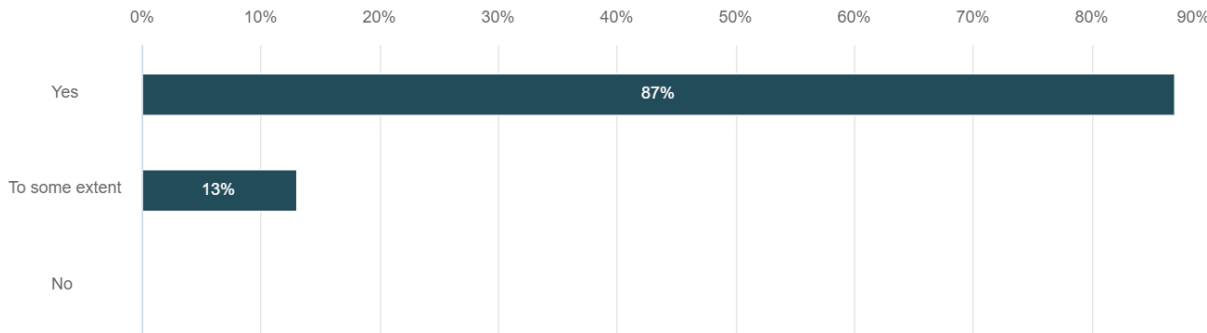
