

CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS

YOUNG CARERS IN FINLAND: LIFE COURSE TRANSITIONS, FAMILY CARE CHAINS AND SUPPORT FOR CARE

The aim of this project is to produce information on young carers in Finland. You may be eligible for the study if:

- You are helping, caring for, or supporting a family member or other person close to you who has a serious illness, disability, injury, mental health disorder or substance abuse problem, or who is very old
- You are a young person or young adult aged 15-24
- You live in Finland

The study will gather qualitative data over four years. Once a year, we will interview participants and ask them to gather participatory data. The participatory data can be a written or audio diary, a lifeline, a social network map or photographs. It takes about 3-5 hours per year to participate in the study. A 60 € work allowance is paid for each year of participation. The study is funded by the Academy of Finland (decision number 359928).
